




WEESSN's Growth in Membership and Staffing Since 2019











Educator Assistance Program (EAP)

Employee benefit that assists employees in resolving personal challenges. EAPs cover a broad range of issues such as relationship challenges, financial or legal problems, wellness, and traumatic events.

Available to every individual employed in a WEESSN network child care program (FCC and GCC) free of charge – and the household/family members.

Services are delivered via phone, video-based counseling, online chatting, e-mail interactions, or face-to-face.







Educator Assistance Program (EAP)

- Mental health counseling
- Unlimited health and wellness coaching
- Legal and financial consultations
- Daily living/convenience referrals
- Confidential coaching about handling difficult situations

For ALL WEESSN-enrolled programs:

- Family child care providers
- Group center staff
- Cooks, bus drivers, bookkeepers, and all other staff
- All family and household members of the above





WEESSN's Impact: High-Quality Care

High-quality care is rooted in daily interactions between children and their care givers.

- Increase public awareness about the benefits of licensed child care






Provider Assistance for Licensing (PAL)

- 18-hour Build it Strong business training course
- 1-to-1 coaching support

- Three grant opportunities per child care business
 - \$40,000 per group center
 - \$20,000 per day camp
 - \$10,000 per family child care program
- Professional development navigation
- Connections to existing resources for the ECE field

- Automated tax worksheets for family child care providers who are working with a tax preparer to ensure proper filing






WEESSN's Impact: Tax Information & Savings

Employee Retention Tax Credit (ERTC) & Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA)

By providing free coaching with national expert Civitas Strategies, WEESSN is helping Wisconsin child care business owners recoup federal tax credits – totaling nearly \$600,000 and growing.

Funds Recouped ERTC = \$553,873 FFCRA = \$32,704

New tax guides enable providers to use efficient, cost-effective online tax preparation tools tailored to child care business scenarios. Available for free across the U.S.
