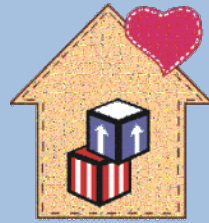

## **The Community Group Early Head Start Child Care Partnership Lawrence, Massachusetts**

- Total number of infant and toddler children served: **72**
- Total program budget: **\$1.4 M** and estimated average cost per child: **\$30,0000**
- Total numbers of child care centers and family child care partners:
  - 2 Centers:** Community Day Early Learning Center; and Teen Parent Infant/Toddler Center at Lawrence High School
  - 15 Family Child Care Providers:** affiliated with TCG's family child care system
- **Descriptive Characteristics of Lawrence Families:** Densely populated urban community (population 77,000); significant immigrant population (Dominican Republic and other Latin American countries); highest Latino population (70%) in the state; 3<sup>rd</sup> highest (51.3/thousand) teen birth rate in the state; Kindergarten population in city schools is 92% Latino, 70% first language Spanish.

# EHS Serving Arapahoe, Garfield, Mesa and Pueblo Counties in Colorado

- ✦ Total program budget = \$3,215,800
- ✦ Total cost/child = \$12,600
- ✦ Total numbers of children served = 240
- ✦ Total numbers of child care center and/or family home partners = 25-35
- ✦ Mostly rural communities with no existing EHS, serving high need working families in Licensed Child Care Centers and Homes, and include dual language learners and teen parents.
